AGGRESSIVE DOG COMPLAINT

On Sunday, February 4, 2007 at 5:41 a.m. the communication center of the Allen Police Department receives a complaint of two aggressive pit bull dogs in the 500 block of Northridge Drive. Allen Police respond but are unable to locate the animals. At 7:16 a.m. a complaint of two aggressive pit bull dogs in the 500 block of Bell Drive is received. Animal control locates the two pit bull dogs at 8:17 a.m. in the 1000 block of Cambridge Drive. The two pit bull dogs charge the Animal Control Officer and she calls for police assistance. The two pit bull dogs charge at one of the responding officer's. Fearing for his the safety the officer fires his service weapon at the charging dogs striking one. The second animal is eventually taken into custody by animal control personnel with the assistance of police. The injured animal is located in the 200 block of E. Bethany where he again charges at police, two officers fire at the charging dog striking the animal which expires at the scene. This incident is currently under investigation by the Allen Police Department.
