****Did you know?** 95% of Storm drains in Allen ultimately drain to Lake Ray Hubbard? Lake Ray Hubbard is a City of Dallas water reservoir. The City of Allen receives its water from North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD). The major reservoir supply for NTMWD is Lavon Lake. This means every time you allow your sprinklers to run to the point of runoff in the street, alley and storm drain, you are sending our precious water supply to the City of Dallas. Please check your sprinklers to insure you have no runoff when using. Excessive runoff of water from a property is not only wasteful, it is a fineable offense.
