**After Hours** - Are defined as any rental occurring between 5:00 p.m. through 10:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. through 10:00 p.m. Saturday through Sunday.

**Business Hours** - are defined as any rental occurring between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

**Non-Profit Organizations** – Organizations that have been recognized by the IRS as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and that operate or maintain facilities in Allen.

**Service Club or Organizations** - means those organizations or clubs who are based in the City of Allen and chartered through a nationally recognized organization providing community service for the citizens of Allen and surrounding communities.

### Permit Re-Inspection Fees

In the event the first inspection or subsequent re-inspections on any permitted work fails to comply with this code or after-hours inspections are requested, fees as shown in **Table 105.8.3** in the fee schedule adopted by resolution of the city council, will be incurred by the permit holder. After-hours inspection requests must be received at least three business days in advance of requested inspection and be approved prior to inspector assignment. All after-hours inspection requests are subject to inspector availability. All fees must be paid prior to scheduling any re-inspections or after-hours inspections.

**Contractor Company Registration.** Any company performing work that requires a permit per this code shall register with the Fire Department, prior to any work being done in this city. Registration shall be good for one year, or at such time the company's state certificate of registration expires. **Refiling.** When a preliminary plat has been disapproved by the commission, and the subdivider refiles a new design for all or a lesser portion of the preliminary plat within 30 days of such disapproval, no new fee shall be charged for the refiling. When a plat has been withdrawn by the applicant, no new fee shall be charged for refiling if submitted within 60 days of the date that the plat is withdrawn. After 60 days, fees shall apply as an original submission.
