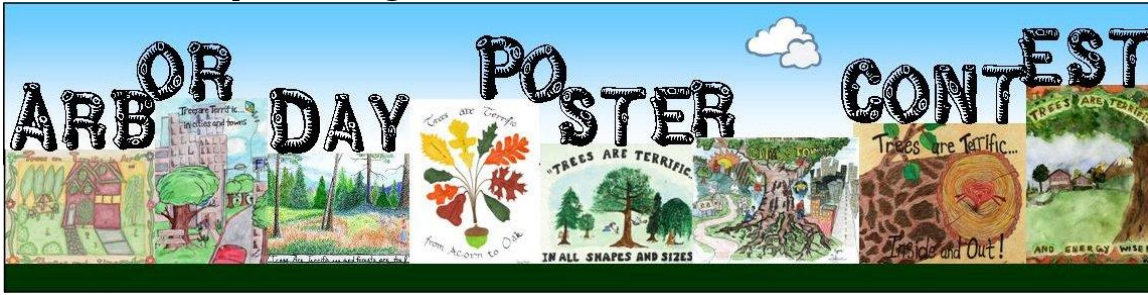


Attention 4th and 5th Grade Students in the Allen ISD!

- ✓ 2019 Theme: **“Trees are Terrific...inside and out!”**
- ✓ 4th and 5th grade students in the Allen ISD may create a poster no smaller than 8 ½” x 11” and no larger than 14” x 18” that reflects their understanding of the environmental benefits and products that trees provide. It is highly recommended that students review the Activity Guide located at <https://cityoffallen.org/974/Public-Education-Outreach> under the December entry. The Rubric (Judging Sheet) is located there too! Just follow the Rubric to create a winning poster!
- ✓ Don't forget to include the theme on the poster, and write your first and last name in the lower right-hand corner on the front of the poster. Write your grade, school, and sponsoring teacher's name on the back of the poster.
- ✓ Turn in your poster to the sponsor (4th or 5th Grade Science Teachers, Environmental PTA Chair, or Environmental Club Leader), _____, at your school by _____. The sponsor will choose the top 3 entries to represent your school and deliver them no later than 5 pm on January 25, 2019 to: Keep Allen Beautiful, c/o Andrea Smith, Allen City Hall, 305 Century Parkway, Allen, Texas 75013
- ✓ One 1st place winner will receive a 3” caliper, 6’ shade tree planted at their school in their honor in late February. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be honored by Keep Allen Beautiful, the Mayor and City Council at a City Council meeting in February. Gift cards to Target will also be presented: 1st place = \$20, 2nd place = \$15, 3rd place = \$10.
